Messages

Enhancing uptake of climate information

- Locational and requirement oriented
- Build on existing capacities and evolve gradually to more sophisticated systems with steady capacity development of NMHSs as well as sector agencies, lead up to end-to-end
- Pilot scalable
- Embedded in national operational systems
- Supported Research inst. & community level agencies
- More user friendly design and web-based system
- Innovative dissemination systems text social media
- Regular feedback sessions participatory process traditional knowledge incorporation – "pull" – based systems
